**RESPONSE TO NOTICE  
OF FORMAL PROCEEDINGS**

**To the California Commission on Judicial Performance:**

Judge Walter L. Blackwell, III, responds to the Notice of Formal Proceedings as follows:

- (1) Answering unnumbered paragraph one, Respondent admits the allegations of said paragraph. Respondent affirmatively alleges that the Commission does not have jurisdiction over a judge for alleged acts occurring prior to becoming a judge.
- (2) Answering unnumbered paragraph two, Respondent admits the allegations of said paragraph.

  - (A) Admits the first sentence:

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(B) Admits the negotiation of the said checks and except as admitted, denies the remaining allegations of said sentence. Respondent affirmatively alleges that at the time of the negotiation of the checks, Fidelity Federal Bank was indebted to Respondent for attorneys fees it had contracted to pay, but unlawfully failed and refused to pay to Respondent for his representation of a former officer of Fidelity.

(5) Answering unnumbered paragraph five, Respondent:

(A) Admits the allegations in the first sentence;

(D) Answering the allegations of the fourth sentence, admits that Fidelity asked during settlement negotiations if Respondent knew of any claims Fidelity might have against Respondent. Respondent denies the remaining allegations of said sentence;

(E) Answering the allegations of the fifth sentence, Respondent admits the allegations of said sentence;

(F) Answering the allegations of the sixth sentence, Respondent admits the allegations of said sentence.

(6) Answering unnumbered paragraph six, Respondent:

(A) Admits the allegations of the first sentence;

(B) Admits the allegations of the second sentence;

(C) Admits that the amount of the checks alleged in the third sentence were eventually

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agreed upon in settlement of Respondent's claim in addition to the mutual general release;

(D) Admits the allegations of the fourth sentence;

(E) Admits the allegations of the fifth sentence;

(7) Answering the allegations of unnumbered paragraph seven, Respondent:

(A) Admits the allegations of the first sentence;

(B) Admits the allegations of the second sentence;

(C) Admits the allegations of the third sentence;

(D) Admits the allegations of the fourth sentence;

(E) Admits the allegations of the fifth sentence;

(F) Admits the allegations of the sixth sentence;

(8) Answering the allegations of unnumbered paragraph eight, Respondent:

(A) Admits the allegations of the first sentence;

(B) Admits the allegations of the second sentence;

(C) Admits the allegations of the third sentence;

(D) Admits the allegations of the fourth sentence;

(E) Admits the allegations of the fifth sentence;

(9) Answering the allegations of unnumbered paragraph nine, Respondent admits the allegations of said paragraph.

(10) Answering the allegations of unnumbered paragraph ten, Respondent denies all of the allegations of said paragraph.

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**AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES**

**First Affirmative Defense**

(11) Article VI, Section 18(d) of the California Constitution does not empower the Commission on Judicial Performance to discipline judges for conduct occurring prior to their assuming office as a judge.

**Second Affirmative Defense**

(12) The matter involving Judge Blackwell was a civil matter resolved by civil litigation and a judgment prior to his taking office as a judge.  
The Commission does not have jurisdiction to discipline a judge for such conduct.

**Third Affirmative Defense**

(13) Even assuming that the Commission has jurisdiction over the present matter, which it does not, the facts alleged do not constitute conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice.

**Fourth Affirmative Defense**

(14) The Commission does not have jurisdiction to determine matters under Business and Professions Code section 6106.

**Fifth Affirmative Defense**

(15) The Commission does not have jurisdiction to discipline a presently sitting judge based upon an alleged violation of the California Code of Judicial Ethics for conduct alleged to have occurred prior to assuming office as a judge. In other words, the Code of Judicial

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Ethics applies to a Judge's conduct during the time he or she is sitting as a judge - it does not apply to the conduct of a person before he or she became a judge.




