ANSWER TO NOTICE OF FORMAL PROCEEDINGS

Respondent Judge Norman $W$. Gordon answers the notice of formal proceedings as follows:

1. Respondent admits the following allegations.
1.1 From January 2, 1983 to the present, Respondent has been a judge of the Los Angeles County Superior Court. Respondent's current term began in January 1991.
1.2 Respondent sent to Racquel Samudio the postcard attached as an exhibit to the Notice of Formal Proceedings and referred to in Count Six.
1.3. Respondent met with Commissioner Anita Shapiro and said that in view of Carol Crawley's bizarre behavior, he was uncomfortable having Crawley work so close to him in Shapiro's courtroom. Later, after talking with Crawley, Respondent told Shapiro he was satisfied to have Crawley work for Shapiro.
1.4 Respondent arranged to have Samudio transferred because of her inappropriate behavior with courtroom staff, lawyers, and Respondent.
2. Respondent denies each and every allegation not expressly admitted and in particular denies that he has been
responsible for misconduct in office or conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice that brings the judicial office into dispute.
