JUDICIAL PERFORMANCE COMMISSION ISSUES PUBLIC ADMONISHMENT OF JUDGE ERNEST M. HIROSHIGE

The Commission on Judicial Performance has publicly admonished Judge Ernest M. Hiroshige of the Los Angeles County Superior Court. The commission determined that it should issue a public admonishment to Judge Hiroshige for improperly delegating the responsibility to conduct case management conferences to his court clerk. Judge Hiroshige continued to engage in this practice despite the private admonishment that the commission imposed in 2010 that addressed, in part, such conduct. The judge's prior discipline was a significant factor in the commission's decision to impose a public admonishment at this time.
