APPEARANCE SCHEDULED BEFORE COMMISSION IN MATTER  
CONCERNING JUDGE MICHAEL F. MURRAY

The Commission on Judicial Performance today announced that an appearance for oral argument before the commission has been scheduled in the matter concerning Judge Michael F. Murray, a judge of the Superior Court of California, County of Orange.

The appearance before the commission will take place on Wednesday, October 19, 2022, commencing at 2:00 p.m. at the Supreme Court of California, 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California. The hearing will be open to the public.

Due to social distancing requirements, seating in the courtroom will be limited. The appearance will be available to the public via live stream webcast. Check the commission's website (<https://cjp.ca.gov>) for a link to the live stream closer to the date and time of the hearing.

Commission Trial Counsel Mark Lizarraga and Assistant Trial Counsel Melissa G. Murphy serve as Examiners for the commission. Judge Murray is represented by Edith R. Matthai, Gabrielle Jackson, and Leigh P. Robie of Los Angeles.

The report of the special masters in this matter, the record of the proceeding before the special masters, and briefs submitted by the parties are available for public inspection by contacting the commission's office. At the appearance before the commission, the parties may present argument concerning the special masters' report and any objections thereto.
