## COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE OPERATIONS AND STRUCTURE OF THE COMMISSION ON JUDICIAL PERFORMANCE TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON DRAFT REPORT ON FEBRUARY 14, 2023

On February 14, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. in the Malcolm M. Lucas Board Room of the Ronald M. George State Office Complex at 455 Golden Gate Avenue, 3rd Floor, San Francisco, the Committee to Review the Operations and Structure of the California Commission on Judicial Performance will hold a public hearing to seek input from the public and all interested stakeholders on its <u>draft report</u>. The draft report is available for review on the <u>Committee page</u> of the CJP website. Testimony may be provided in person, in writing or virtually through a link on the agenda that will be posted on the committee page of the CJP website on Friday, February 3, 2023.

The interest underlying the work of this Committee is to ensure that the operations and structure of the Commission on Judicial Performance is designed to support its mission to protect the public, enforce rigorous standards of judicial conduct, and maintain public confidence in the integrity and independence of the judiciary. Established in 1960, the CJP is the independent state agency responsible for investigating complaints of judicial misconduct and judicial incapacity and for disciplining judges, pursuant to article VI, section 18 of the <u>California Constitution</u>. Recommendations from the Committee are intended to benefit the work of the CJP and improve its operation. The Committee, which by statute includes representatives of the CJP, the judiciary, a director from the judicial conduct commission from a state of comparable size, and appointed public and attorney members, has invited input from the public and stakeholder groups throughout this process on matters pertaining to the operations and structure of the CJP. The Committee will present a final report to the Governor and other key state officials no later than March 30, 2023.
