COMMISSION ON JUDICIAL PERFORMANCE ISSUES PUBLIC ADMONISHMENT OF JUDGE LILLIAN VEGA JACOBS

The Commission on Judicial Performance has publicly admonished Judge Lillian Vega Jacobs of the Los Angeles County Superior Court.

The commission determined that it should publicly admonish Judge Jacobs for unlawful action in driving under the influence of alcohol, being convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol, and driving with a blood alcohol content of twice the legal limit. The commission further determined that Judge Jacobs's misconduct demonstrated a serious disregard of the principles of personal and official conduct embodied in the Code of Judicial Ethics.
